

Proposed Permit Fees

All the Local Authorities in the Yorkshire Common Permit Scheme have set their permit fees in accordance with the Traffic Management Act 2004 Permit Fees Guidance published by Department for Transport (DfT) in July 2008. The fees reflect individual local authority administration costs and are structured to reflect the greater effort involved in handling larger activities and busier roads.

In some instances fees can be waived or reduced such as in the case of any utility works where two or more companies propose works that involve sharing the same working space.
